ABOUT THE CAMP

Facilities: Athletic fields at Illinois Wesleyan University will be utilized as the primary soccer training facilities. Additional facilities at and near campus may also be utilized during the week.

Lodging: Housing will be provided at Illinois Wesleyan University dormitories. Two campers per room. Roommate preferences must be filled in on the registration form and must check-in at registration together.

Trainers: A full time athletic trainer will be on site to administer attention to minor injuries and ailments. For more serious problems, local hospitals will be utilized. All campers must return the completed medical form before camp. Parent Signature is required.

Supervision: All campers will be supervised 24 hours a day by summer camp housing staff.

Team Camp Program: Teams are welcome to attend and will train as a team and work on tactical issues and different systems of play. Coaches may come and observe their teams or let coaches know what system they would like to train.

Team Discount: Teams that register 10 or more players receive \$10 off. All registrations and deposits must be in the same envelope.

Deadline: Registration form must be received by July 1st to attend camp. Camper enrollment is limited. Sign up early to assure a spot.

Early Registration Discount: Registration that is postmarked before June 15th will receive \$15 off.

Commuters: are welcome but will not stay in the dormitories. These campers must provide their own transportation to and from camp.
